Wow, it's amazing that we are already deep into planning our next WEG tour, when it seems like only the other day that we were all having fun on our Australian and New Zealand THM tour to the WEG in Aachen. Roz and I have been to Lexington a few times now. It is a great place to visit. Everything you've heard about those Bluegrass Thoroughbred studs is true, and MORE. You just can't believe how flash they are. Racing at Keeneland is another special thrill, suddenly you are at the racecourse that featured in all those movies about racing, a track with an historic down-south feel.

The Horse Park where the WEG is being held is another great bonus for the event. This is Kentucky's largest tourist attraction and is used to holding lots of horse shows, and, of course, the famed Kentucky Rolex 3 Day Event is held there every year.

For the WEG there are lots and lots of new facilities being built and we'll be over to check everything out, because once again, the secret of a good tour is that every aspect is road-tested well in advance.

Accommodation is a bit of a problem in Lexington. The standard place to stay is a big motel stuck on a big tollway surrounded by fast food outlets. We really did have to search a while before we came up with a fine hotel in the historic and very beautiful town of Frankfort, and it's only 20 minutes from the WEG site! The American organisers are well aware that so many Americans are going to want to come to the WEG, that they don't have to worry much about overseas visitors, so they are driving a very hard bargain. The tickets cost about twice the price they were for the Aachen WEG, and we had to pay a 50% deposit by August 1 2008 and the balance earlier this year! Still we have been very happy to see that so many of our travellers – from both sides of the Tasman - who made the journey with us to Jerez in 2002, and Aachen in 2006, have expressed their interest in joining us on the exciting journey to Lexington.

As with all the THM tours, we'll be offering lots of interesting side trips and special events – once you have signed up we will keep you up to date with all the latest developments.

1. Reservations and Deposits

Reservations subject to availability, will only be confirmed upon receipt of the completed reservation form with the non-refundable deposit of AUD\$5350 per person to be received on application. An additional AUD\$3100 full payment for the 2010 WEG Season Tickets.

2. Further Deposit and Balance

Further Deposit due 30th July 2010 \$3500

Single supplement fees where applicable due 30th July 2010 \$3950

3. Cancellation of Booking Application

- Cancellations after registration 2010 – 100% of all deposits paid

- Cancellations after 30th July 2010 – 100% of all deposits paid

4. Alteration to Tour Prices

The tour fares are based on airfares and exchange rates as at the date of printing. Any airfare and associated taxes increases prior to departure must be borne by the passenger(s). In the event of international currency fluctuations or amendments to the itinerary necessitated by unforeseen circumstances, the tour cost will be adjusted accordingly, and the additional cost, if any must be paid by the passenger(s). Should this be unacceptable, the passenger(s) reserves the right to cancel the reservations held, subject to the cancellation charges as detailed in Clause 3 above should these charges reduce the tour cost; the applicable refund will be made.
